Tour itinerary from Mid West



Depending on departure city; this itinerary may need to be revised.

Day 1~ Saturday- This morning depart aboard your motorcoach for an overnight stay in Lexington, Kentucky area. Dinner is on your own tonight.

Day 2~ Sunday- After breakfast we depart for historic Richmond, VA for a one night stay. Dinner is included this evening. (B,D)

Day 3~Monday- After a **tour of Virginia's State Capital, Richmond**, we board our motorcoach and travel to **Virginia Beach**. Upon our arrival we will check into our **oceanfront hotel**. Tonight we visit the **Virginia Beach Convention Center** for an evening of fun! We begin with a delicious buffet including some favorite foods of Virginia. After dinner, once the tables are cleared, the evening's music tribute is **"New Jersey Nights," The Story of The Jersey Boys**: Frankie Valli and The Four Seasons. The lead singer plays Frankie Valli in his 20's and performs wonderful versions of "Sherry," "Big Girls Don't Cry," "Walk Like a Man," and, of course, "Oh What A Night." (B,D)

Day 4~ Tuesday- After breakfast at the hotel we will depart for an 18th Century Revolutionary experience in **Colonial Williamsburg**. Included is time to explore the Colonial area including the Capitol and Governor's Palace. This afternoon return to the hotel with time to relax. Tonight's entertainment is at **the Cavalier Hotel**, whose oceanfront ballroom is where the Big Bands of the 30's, 40's, and 50's played on Saturday Nights. Enjoy a candlelight seafood buffet. As dinner concludes the **Tommy Dorsey Orchestra** takes the stage and performs prior to the headline event: **"The Sinatra Legacy"**, a special tribute to the music of Frank Sinatra. The dance floor will be swinging as our tribute artist performs hits like "I've Got You Under My Skin," "Fly Me to the Moon," and more. We chose a Frank Sinatra Act for our USO Show not only because of his musical fame during the 40's and 50's but because he played the Cavalier Ballroom. (B,D)

Day 5~ Wednesday- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel this morning and spend the remainder of the morning at your leisure. Take a stroll on the beach or boardwalk and visit the local shops for special mementos. *An optional visit to the Virginia Aquarium & Marine Science Center will be offered.* Touch, interact, and explore one of the largest aquariums on the East Coast. This afternoon we are off to the **Virginia Beach Military Aviation Museum**, where you will see more than 65 military aircraft from WWI and WWII. Then take your seat by the airfield for **"SwingTime in the Skies."** But before the show starts **an open-air, antique, English Double Decker Bus drives up sporting the Glenn Miller AAF B with Bob Hope, The Andrews Sisters and the entire Glenn Miller Band in WWII uniforms.** Our celebrities and musicians then join the audience for the **"SwingTime in the Skies" Air-Show**, featuring narration and music of the era with flyovers featuring both Tri-Planes and Bi-Planes. Once the Air Show ends everyone enjoys a **Southern Style Cookout** in the Hangar. Tonight we are off to the **Sandler Center Performance Hall for King Neptune's USO Show**. This headline event begins with a **"Ceremonial Big Check Presentation"** by Bob Hope and others to the USO of Hampton Roads. Then our entertainers take over and you will enjoy a nostalgic **"Thanks for the Memories" evening with the comedy of Bob Hope, the harmony of the incomparable Andrews Sisters, and a 14-piece orchestra that is a tribute to the greatest military band of all time: The Glenn Miller AAF Band.** The evening is a tribute to these performers who, more than any others, entertained America's Troops while they served overseas. (B,D)

Day 6~ Thursday- After breakfast at the hotel we will depart for our overnight accommodations in Morehead, Kentucky. Dinner is on your own. (B)

Day 7~ Friday - Your last morning includes breakfast at the hotel before departing for home with fond USO memories. (B)
